<p><b>CAFOD St Helen's pray-fast-give</b>  <b>ADVENT APPEAL</b>  The situation in Gaza is in the forefront of the minds of people believing in justice, mercy and peace across the world and aid agencies globally, including CAFOD, working through partners, continue to seek the access needed and the freedom of movement necessary to meet the needs of those desperate, displaced families within the Israeli controlled Gaza strip. Whilst those Palestinians in the West Bank Territory of Palestine face nothing like the challenges that their compatriots in Gaza have to, their different needs require different support.</p>	<p><b>Irenaeus:</b> On Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> January, at the Irenaeus Centre 32 Great Georges Road L22 1RD we welcome a well-known speaker David Wells to lead our next 'Come &amp; See' day. David is married to Alison and has three grown-up children. He started out as a teacher in Liverpool. Since then, he has gained an M(Phil), worked as a researcher, Education Advisor, Director of Formation and now works as a speaker and writer. He has spoken at 1500 conferences around the world.</p>
